

BOLOGNA AIRPORT: 680,000 PASSENGERS IN FEBRUARY (+5.9%) *The best February ever for Marconi Airport*

Another month of growth for Bologna Airport. In February, **Marconi's passenger traffic reached 681,053**, marking an increase of 5.9% compared to the same month in 2025. This is the best February ever recorded in the airport's history.

More specifically, **domestic passengers totaled 157,291**, up 2.9% from 2025, while **international passengers reached 523,762**, an increase of 6.9% over 2025.

There were **4,960 aircraft movements during the month**, up 3.9% compared to 2025, while freight reached 3,493 tons, with an increase of 0.8%.

Monday, 16 February, was the busiest day of the month, with 31,327 passengers.

The most popular destinations in February 2026 were: Catania, Tirana, and Barcelona in the top three positions. Completing the month's "top ten" were: Madrid, Paris CDG, Palermo, Istanbul, Bucharest, London Heathrow and Amsterdam.

In the first two months of the year, total passengers at Marconi reached 1,383,644, up 5.0% compared to the same period in 2025. Aircraft movements for the two-month period totaled 10,114, with an increase of 2.6% over the corresponding period in 2025. Freight in the first two months of 2026 amounted to 6,752 tons, with a slight decrease (-0.2%) compared to 2025.

Aeroporto Guglielmo Marconi di Bologna, classified as a "strategic airport" in the centre-north area of the National Airports Plan prepared by the Ministry of Infrastructure and Transport, recorded in 2025 11.1 million passengers, ranking as the seventh biggest Italian airport by number of passengers (Source: Assaeroporti – Aeroporti2030). Located in the heart of the Emilian food valley and the automotive and packaging industrial districts, the airport has a catchment area of about 11 million inhabitants and around 47,000 companies, with a strong propensity to exports and internationalisation and with commercial expansion policies to Eastern Europe and Asia.

As for airport infrastructure, the airport has among its strategic objectives in the next few years an important development plan that mainly concerns the expansion of the terminal, particularly in the gate area. The company's aim is to make Bologna Airport one of the most modern and functional in Italy, an important gateway to the city and region.
