### **Rekeep S.p.A.: The Board of Directors approves the Interim Management Report as at 31 March 2026, showing a recovery across all key economic indicators**

#### ***Main consolidated results for the first quarter of FY2026 vs. first quarter of FY2025:***

- **Revenues: €333.6 million**, up from €319.8 million at 31 March 2025;
- **Adjusted<sup>1</sup> EBITDA<sup>2</sup>: €29.6 million**, up from €25.2 million at 31 March 2025;
- **Adjusted<sup>2</sup> EBIT: €17.9 million**, up from €13.4 million at 31 March 2025;
- **Net Result: substantially break-even (negative €0.4 million)**, improving from the loss of €9.5 million at 31 March 2025;
- **Net Financial Debt: €557.6 million**, compared to €540.1 million at 31 March 2025;
- **Tendered and renewed existing contracts: €110 million**, compared to €176 million at 31 March 2025;
- **Tender pipeline awaiting award: €3.6 billion**, compared to €2.2 billion at 31 March 2025;
- **Total order backlog and renewals: €2.7 billion**, in line with €2.7 billion at 31 March 2025.

*Zola Predosa (Bologna), 15 May 2026* – The Board of Directors of **Rekeep S.p.A.** (“**Rekeep**”), parent company of the leading Italian group operating in the Integrated Facility Management sector, met today under the chairmanship of Claudio Levorato and examined and approved the **Interim Management Report as at 31 March 2026**, which shows a recovery of the business, both in terms of revenues and margins. The volume of tenders submitted and awaiting award also increased, reflecting the revival in commercial activity.

#### **Key Consolidated Results as at 31 March 2026**

As at 31 March 2026, **Revenues** for the Rekeep Group **amounted to €333.6 million**, up **4.3%** compared to €319.8 million as at 31 March 2025. In particular, positive performance in international markets was confirmed, supported by the Group’s entry into Portugal in the first quarter of 2026 through the acquisition of a 60% stake in Euromex Facility Services, now renamed Rekeep Portugal. **Adjusted EBITDA** amounted to **€29.6 million**, compared to €25.2 million as at 31 March 2025, up **17.4%**, mainly driven by improved performance, particularly in the facility management and energy management segments.

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<sup>1</sup> Adjusted EBIT and EBITDA: values net of “non-recurring” income components or costs for operations that are not repeated frequently in the normal course of business.

<sup>2</sup> EBITDA is defined as operating income before accruals to the provisions for risks, the reversal of provisions and amortization/depreciation, write-downs and write-backs of assets. EBITDA is used by the management to monitor and assess the Company’s performance and is not an accounting measure under IFRS. Accordingly, EBITDA should not be considered as an alternative to assess the Group’s performance. In view of the fact that EBITDA is not regulated by accounting principles, our determination of EBITDA may differ from the determination made by other companies and may therefore not be comparable to the latter.



**Adjusted EBIT** amounted to **€17.9 million**, compared to €13.4 million as at 31 March 2025, up **33.6%**, for the same reasons.

The **Net Result** as at 31 March 2026 is **negative for €0.4 million, substantially breakeven, showing an improvement** compared to the loss of €9.5 million as at 31 March 2025. The change is also partly attributable to the capital gain related to the sale of the stake in NewCo DUC, amounting to €2.4 million, divested in the first quarter of 2026 to Alba Infra Partners as part of the partnership announced on 22 January.

**Net Financial Indebtedness** amounted to **€557.6 million** as at 31 March 2026, compared to €540.1 million as at 31 March 2025, mainly as a result of increased investments supporting the development of new businesses. As at 31 December 2025, Net Financial Indebtedness amounted to €520.1 million, with the change over the quarter mainly attributable to the seasonality of net working capital, which typically rises in the first part of the year.

#### **Business highlights**

As at 31 March 2026, **the Rekeep Group secured new contracts and renewals worth approximately €110 million over multiple years**, compared to €176 million as at 31 March 2025. In particular, the value of contracts awarded in the healthcare sector was equal to approximately 49% of total.

The volume of tenders submitted and awaiting award stood at **€3.6 billion**, compared to €2.2 billion as at 31 March 2025, reflecting the revival in commercial activity.

The Rekeep Group's **total backlog of tendered and renewed existing contracts** stood at **€2.7 billion** as at 31 March 2026, in line with €2.7 billion as at 31 March 2025.

#### **Main events as at 31 March 2026**

On 22 January 2026, Rekeep Group and Alba Infra Partners, an independent infrastructure fund manager based in Paris and London, announced the launch of MFMC II, a new platform focused on accelerating the development of infrastructure projects. MFMC II is 95% invested by Alba and 5% by the Rekeep Group through Rekeep S.p.A. and Teckal S.p.A. On March 26, 2026, the first closing of the joint venture was completed, and MFMC II acquired the stake held by Rekeep in NewCo DUC Bologna S.p.A., special purpose vehicle (SPV) related to the concession for the new headquarters of the Municipality of Bologna, for a consideration of approximately €10 million. The Rekeep Group retains a minimal stake (2%) and will continue to provide the services envisaged under the concession.

On 26 January 2026, the Rekeep Group announced the acquisition, through its subsidiary Rekeep World, involving 60% of the share capital of the Portuguese company Euromex Facility Services Lda,



which operates in the facility management sector and specializes in hygiene and cleaning services for healthcare buildings.

### **Significant events after 31 March 2026**

On 5 May 2026, the Rekeep Group announced the finalisation, through its subsidiary Rekeep World, of a consortium contract for the design, construction and operation of a hospital in Uzbekistan, in the Fergana region. The contract, awarded by the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Uzbekistan with the support of the country's Ministry of Economy and Finance, has a duration of 20 years and a total value attributable to the Group of approximately Euro 80 million. Under the contract, the Rekeep Group will provide, without any equity investment, maintenance services, plant management services and medical equipment services, ensuring the highest standards of safety and clinical quality. The provision of these services is scheduled to begin in 2029, upon the expected completion of construction works.

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**Rekeep S.p.A.**

Rekeep S.p.A. is the leading Italian operator and one of the main European players in the Integrated Facility Management sector, i.e., it manages and provides integrated services targeted at properties, the environment and in support of healthcare services. From plant management to cleaning, from green care to maintenance and energy retrofit of buildings, to specialist work for clinics and hospitals (laundering and sterilization), Rekeep provides a wide range of ancillary services to the core business of large private groups, public entities and healthcare facilities. Building on its know-how in the energy field, it has also been operating for years in the area of energy retrofit of properties, providing its customers with solutions for reducing emissions and consumption. Rekeep's headquarter is located in Zola Predosa (Bologna), operating offices in Poland, France, Portugal, Middle East and Turkey, and employs approximately 28,000 people in Italy and abroad.
